

# The Les Bois Spring Classic

June 4 & 5, 2021

SHOW AT YOUR OWN RISK!

1. The Les Bois Spring Classic will be under the direction of Kirk Pugsley for Swine Show, Steer & Market Heifer Show, Sheep, & Goat Show both Ring A and Ring B.
2. The Les Bois Spring Classic will be sanctioned by The Snake River Show Circuit as well as the Oregon Junior Pork Producers 2021 Sweepstakes Series.
3. The Les Bois Spring Classic will operate under the rules of the Snake River Show Circuit.
4. Proper show ring attire is required and should follow standard 4-H or FFA guidelines. No open toed shoes, short pants, tank tops or shirts not covering the shoulder or midriff accepted.
5. There will be no refund of entry or pen fees.
6. Sawdust pen bedding must be used.
7. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning of pens before leaving the grounds; failure to do so will result in forfeit of premiums.
8. If planning on showing out of trailer, please plan to clean area around trailer making sure that area is left as you found it when departing. Trailer parking is limited in proximity to show rings. No Parking next to building allowed for fire protection reasons. There will be no parking of vehicles on grass areas! Barriers may not be moved unless approved by show management ahead of time.
9. The show manager will handle any problems, questions, and situations before, during or after the show that may arise covered or otherwise not covered by the printed rules. All decisions will be at the discretion of the Show Managers, and will be final, and not subject to appeal.
10. All entries must be postmarked by Monday May 28<sup>th</sup> to receive the \$30/head pre-registration fee. After May 28<sup>th</sup>, \$50/head fee. Entries must be made on the entry form, and photocopies will be accepted. Entries made at check-in will be at the late entry fee and will only be accepted in the form of cash, No Exceptions!
11. All animal entries must be entered by ear notch or numbered ID/scrapie tag that is permanently attached to the animal. No exceptions!!
12. Show open to youth 2-19 years old as of January 1 of the current year.
13. All animals will be weighed, and classes will be set after completion of weigh-in.
14. Any hogs weighing 300 pounds and under are welcome. No max weight for market lambs, or market goats or market steers.
15. Check in and weigh in will be as follows:
  - Hogs: 6-8 pm Thursday June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 7-9 am Friday, June 4<sup>th</sup>, & 7-8 am Saturday, June 5<sup>th</sup>.
  - Sheep & Goats: 6-8 pm Thursday June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 7-9 am Friday, June 4<sup>th</sup>, & 7-8 am Saturday, June 5<sup>th</sup>.
  - Crossbred-Heifers/Steers: 6-8 pm Friday, June 4<sup>th</sup>, & 7-8 am Saturday, June 5<sup>th</sup>.
16. Initial weights will be used for both show rings. No re-weigh for different days.
17. **\*\*New This Year\*\*** Breeding Divisions
  - Breeding Gilts-under 300 lbs. Sorted by weight.
  - Breeding Doelings must be under 1 year old. Sorted by weight.
  - Breeding Ewe Lambs Must be under 1 year old. Sorted by weight.
  - Breeding Heifers Pedigree must list youth as owner of the animal & will be split in the following classes based on Registration Papers DOB:
    - November-December 2020
    - September-October 2020
    - July-August 2020
    - May-June 2020
    - March-April 2020
    - January-February 2020
    - November- December 2019
    - September-October 2019
    - Crossbred Heifers based on weights
18. 100% of entry fees will go into the Jackpot.
19. All livestock from outside of Idaho must have proper health papers. Consult your veterinarian.

20. All animals must be free of diseases. We reserve the right to remove or reject any animal due to health concerns.
21. Proof of ownership will be required at check in.
22. Exhibitors are responsible for the care and grooming of their own animals. We encourage parent assistance keeping in mind this is a Jr. Show.
23. All exhibitors are encouraged to enter Showmanship. Exhibitors must show their own animal (Pewee division is exempt from this rule). Showmanship entry fee will be \$10 per youth. Pewee Division is exempt for showmanship fee. Showmanship will be divided by age of the participant.

### **Special Covid 19 Guidelines**

1. Whenever possible social distancing of 6 feet should be observed.
2. Family groups are encouraged to be seated together allowing adequate distancing from other family groups.
3. If you have symptoms suspicious of Covid 19 we ask that you not attend or participate at the Les Bois Spring Classic. If you do not know about Covid 19 symptoms yet, crawl back under your rock 😊.
4. Usage of masks is a personal choice and as such we will not tolerate any ridicule of persons choosing to either wear or not wear a mask. Anyone that is observed causing problems will be disqualified and will be removed from the exhibition grounds. Political agendas have no place at this show, our intent is to facilitate youth exhibition of livestock in a fun, happy environment.
